This is a summary of the annual report of the Group Life Insurance Plan for Employees of St. Lawrence University, Employer Identification Number 15-0532239, Plan No. 504, for the period January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009. The annual report has been filed with the U.S. Department of Labor's Pension and Welfare Benefits Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with the Prudential Insurance Company of America and Continental Casualty Company to pay all claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2009 were \$149,265.71.
